Terms and Conditions

1. Authorized site. An authorized site is a single localized setting that is under an individual administration and may be academic or nonacademic. For academic institutions, different campuses are considered different sites even if they are within the same city. Departments or libraries of the same campus are considered part of the same site. Consortium membership is currently not included as an authorized site.

The Subscriber's online access includes authorization by means of the Subscriber's IP address(es), and allows site-wide access by authorized users. IP address(es) must be valid and provided by the Subscriber to the Publisher. Only the IP address(es) provided by the Subscriber will have access to the material. There is no maximum limit of the number of IP addresses or workstations at an authorized site under this License. If a proxy server is being registered for access, the Subscriber agrees to maintain the security of the access by authenticating authorized users before allowing use of the proxy to any remote or on-site user.

2. Authorized user. Authorized users are Individual subscribers or Institutional subscriber users who are employees, faculty, staff, students officially affiliated with the Subscriber, or authorized on-site patrons of the Subscriber's library facilities. Authorized users may be persons remote from the Subscriber's physical location whose access is administered from the Subscriber's site or campus.
